Additional Information

Homework Timetable:



Each primary class has their own homework timetable, which your class teacher will inform you of.

You or the class teacher should record your homework in the homework diary. Please make sure your parents check your diary each week, and sign it.

Most weeks, you should get a piece of numeracy and literacy homework, and spellings and timetables. Your teacher may give additional homework.



Reading:

Along with written homework, you must read everyday. Share your reading books with your parents or older brothers and sisters. Your teacher will give you reading books accompanied by a reading record, ask your parents to comment in the reading record. Books that are damaged or lost will have to be paid for.



Wudhu & Cleanliness:

You must come to school with wudhu, as you will recite Qur’an each morning, and you will read Salah during the day.

Being clean is very important in Islam therefore you must be clean at all times.

Absences:

If you are absent from school, you must bring a note the following day, explaining the reason of your absence.

Late arrivals:

Please make sure you to come to school on time.

Lunch:



You will need to bring a pack lunch. The school tuck shop sells drinks, chocolate and crisps which you can purchase at break time.
